# Dear Friends

It is very difficult for me to write this letter and for you to read it on Easter Sunday. However, the Finance Council has strongly urged me to do so, allowing the largest possible reading audience to be achieved. In brief, the parish will run a deficit of about \$30,000 by the end of June. This is represented by a 13.3% decline in weekly Offertory from \$238,369 to \$207,280 over the last two years as well as an increase in expenses associated with running a vibrant parish. Without correcting this problem, the parish will not be able to continue to pay its bills and the salaries of the employees. There is \$18,000 in the parish savings account which will take us through April and perhaps the first part of May. As you know, the weekly collections in June, July and August are significantly smaller than the other nine months of the year. The parish needs your help and it needs your assistance now.

If you do not worship with us on a regular basis but count on the services of the parish for Baptisms, CCD, Youth Ministry, Vacation Bible School, First Communions, Confirmations, Funerals or Weddings, we need your help to continue to provide those services. The 20 % of parishioners who attend Mass regularly can no longer pay for the services used by the parishioners who do not contribute to the support of the parish. This is especially true for the 750 children who are enrolled in our CCD Program. Unfortunately, only about 200 children and their parents attend Mass. The tuition that we charge pays for about 1/3 of the cost of running our program. The parish no longer can subsidize the other 2/3 of the cost of this program. Because of the financial situation that we find ourselves in, the CCD program will need to be self sufficient. For this to happen, the tuition will have to increase significantly. Believe me, the Finance Council and I do not want to see the fees increase and this decision will be difficult, but due to the offertory issues, we have no choice. I hope that the increase can be minimized by a significant increase in the contributions from parishioners, who for whatever reason, do not worship with us regularly. The simple act of using the parish envelope system as a reminder that the parish needs your help tends to make an impact. Also, there are other ways that you can support the parish such as the monthly drawing known as the 300 club. The form to enroll in this fundraiser can

be found in the bulletin. Also, you will find a form to purchase 50/50 raffle tickets which hopefully will give the winner a sizable amount of money, as well as benefit our parish. This parish is a very important part of the East Bridgewater community. This parish has a history of responding well to crisis. Let us once again, come together to support God's work in our community
