

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Friends

Last week I wrote to you regarding the Pastoral Planning that has begun in the Archdiocese of Boston. I mentioned that each of the 290 parishes will belong to a Pastoral Collaborative which will be administered by one pastor who ordinarily will not come from one of the parishes that the collaborative will serve. Last Wednesday, the priests of the South Region met and the collaboratives that each parish in this region will belong to were announced. The collaborative that we will belong to consists of the following parishes: St. John the **Evangelist in East Bridgewater, St. Thomas** Aguinas in Bridgewater and St. Ann in West Bridgewater. This is a proposal and each staff member and the PPC and the FC will meet with the Pastoral Planning Committee for their input and, indeed, some of these meetings have already taken place. This change in the way parishes will be administered will be profound and I want you to be kept up-to-date with these pending pastoral changes. Please make use of the Pastoral Planning web site which is www.planning2012.com where you will be able to monitor this process for yourself. There will be several meetings here for me to gather your thoughts and concerns in the future. As always, I will keep you informed.
