

I want to encourage everyone who may be away on vacation during the summer months to remember St. John's in your vacation budget. I believe that everyone knows that we are having serious financial troubles here and had to make some staff reductions. If you are going to be away, please send in your contribution before you leave or simply place it in the collection plate when you return. Many thanks for your understanding.

Finally, the lift in the parish hall is no longer working. The company that installed the lift is out of business. The type of lift that we have is no longer one that can be approved for use in a public building. It has an inspection citation that says it can be in use until 2014. I have had one electrician examine it and it is his opinion that it can't be fixed. I will have another town electrician look at it as well to see if it can be repaired. But at this time the hall is not handicap accessible. I will inform the Sachem Nursing Home that we cannot, at this time, be an evacuation center for their residents in the event that their building is not useable, as has happened once before. In case you are wondering- the cost to put an elevator in the church that would also service the parish hall is \$250,000.
