Dear Friends.

The parish family is well aware that meetings have been taking place

involving the Building/Renovation committee, the Parish Finance Council and the Parish Pastoral Council regarding the expansion of the seating area and the renovation and updating of the church which was built in 1954. I would ask you all to go to the parish web site--www.stjohneb.org and take a look at the preliminary drawings (there are four models) and their corresponding construction cost as well as additional costs incurred apart from the construction costs. At some point in the upcoming months more detailed drawing from the firm of ADC (Architectural Design Concepts) will be presented to the parish. No decision has been made to actually go forward. However, the three committees are in total agreement that there is a definite need to do something. Why? The Archdiocese is going to submit a pastoral plan for the future in the next few months because the number of priests will soon be fewer than the number of parishes. Since the Vatican has indicated that closing parishes is not going to be part of the future reconfiguration process, one pastor will be needed to shepherd more than one parish. Therefore, the number of Masses in each parish will need to be reduced.

We all know that our church is crowded now with four Masses, thus something will have to be done at some point when the number of Masses is reduced from four to perhaps two or three. Whatever the details of the new pastoral plan for the future of the Archdiocese are and whenever they are to be implemented is not clear vet but we need to plan for the future of our great parish and we need to do so with a sense of urgency and not complacency.

Apart from all of these future plans, our church is nearly 60 years old and much of it is in need of renovation and updating. Heating/AC, painting, elevator, carpeting, flooring, sprinkler system to name but a few are basic items that we as a parish need to think about, as well as, some kind of additional seating. Whatever is going to happen we will do it together and with a sense of unity and pride and also with an overriding transparency that will make clear to all what our future will be.
