Dear Friends,

Last week I wrote to you regarding the important and necessary

planning that is required of every parish. This planning or "pastoral planning" as it is called is required because of the lack of priests available to serve in the 290 parishes of the Archdiocese. Also, 30% of these parishes are in debt, 40% are just able to pay their bills and the salaries of a reduced staff, having no reserve to call upon (that's us). While some parishes have large buildings with fewer and fewer parishioners, others have small buildings with a growing congregation (that's us too). Because of this situation, Cardinal Sean has brought together a large cross section of the Archdiocese, including professional planners, to propose a Pastoral Plan for the future because maintaining the status quo is not possible. Much of their work is done and the Cardinal has called for a meeting of all of the priests of the Archdiocese on Monday, Dec. 5 from 1:00-5:00 at the Burlington Marriott to discuss this Pastoral Plan. As always, I will keep you informed.

On a more enjoyable note, I attended the East Bridgewater High School's Soccer and Cross Country matches during the past two weeks and I am happy to report that both teams were very successful. Also, I attended the EBHS National Honor Society induction ceremony on Tuesday evening. The young people from our parish were very well represented at all of these events. This Sunday afternoon, Father Kani and I will be conducting a retreat at Miramar Retreat Center in Duxbury for the members of the Saint Vincent de Paul Society. Your prayers are requested for the success of this retreat. I also want to thank all those who brought bags of food to the Masses last weekend—you were an inspiration.
