Dear Friends,

It is hard to imagine that Holy Week begins on Saturday April 16 or one week from Saturday. Our Lenten journey has gone quickly and it will quickly come to an end. But before it ends let me offer a little spiritual advice. First, put the Holy Week services, that is, Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday in your calendar and in your family's calendar. The services on Holy Thursday and Good Friday are at 7:00 pm and on Holy Saturday the service is at 7:30. Do your best to make sure that you celebrate the great events of our salvation as a family. On Easter Sunday we will have the regular schedule of Masses which is: 8:00, 9:30 and 11:30. Following the 9:30 Mass, there will be an Easter Egg hunt for the children. Second, try to come to either the Chaplet of Divine Mercy or the daily Mass at least once before Easter. The Chaplet is celebrated on Monday at 6:00 pm and daily Mass is celebrated on Wednesday thru Friday at 6:30 PM. Thirdly, try to come to the Sacrament of Penance before Easter. At St. John's, the sacrament is celebrated on Wednesday evening from 7:00-7:30 or on Saturday from 3:00-3:30. (The sacrament will not be celebrated on Holy Saturday.)

My last bit of Lenten advice is to try to take some alone time to realize how blessed you are and how much God truly loves you.

Finally, I will begin my eighth year among you in a few months. By this time I know that I can sound like a broken record, but, I would once again ask you to join the 300 club. The cost is \$5 per month or 15 cents per day. There are very few people in this parish who can't afford 15 cents per day. Presently, we have about 120 members in the 300 club. If we had 300 members, the parish would realize about \$20,000 in profit. It is such a painless and inexpensive way to help out your parish. If you are not a member, simply cut out the form in today's bulletin and return it to the parish office. You can do so by mail, in the Sunday collection or in person. Consider it an Easter gift to your parish.
