



# Parish and Youth Ministry

Our Ministry is completely self-funded through our events and direct fundraising. Total monies raised are put back into the program to allow some programs to run at no cost to families, bringing speakers and musicians to our Parish, rent transportation to events, support service projects and supplement the costs of the travel programs. In our first year of Ministry, we were very blessed with the support and generosity of our Parish to raise approximately \$11,000. Our goal this year is to raise \$15,000 in total, with approximately half of the money raised going towards the expenses associated with our Mission Trip to Nashville, TN.

We are very grateful to Sharon Lawler and Hazel Tessier for volunteering to Chair our Fundraising efforts. These ladies have a tremendous energy to help make our new Ministry a success.
