Lenten Regulations

Ash Wednesday, February 22nd, marks the beginning of Lent. The following fasting and abstinence regulations are observed. Abstinence from meat is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent by all Catholics 14 years and older. Fasting is observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those bound by this rule may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted and necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. From its earliest days, the Church has urged the baptized and the catechumens to observe the threefold discipline of fasting, almsgiving and prayer as preparation for the celebration of Easter.

It is hard to imagine but Lent is upon us. I am excited about the various

devotions that will be offered here at St. John's. Ash Wednesday is Feb. 22. Mass will be celebrated at 9:00 am and at 7:00 pm in the church. This is a very important day for us all. This is the day that we come into contact with that part of us that needs to seek forgiveness. It is also the day that we chose to "give something up" and by doing so fill that empty space in our lives with God's grace. When the priest or deacon or lay person place the ashes on your forehead they will say, "Turn away from sin and believe in the Good News." I pray that the ashes will be an exterior sign of an interior conversion for you and for me.

During Lent Mass will be offered each morning at 9:00 (M-F). On Wednesday evening at 6:30 the Chaplet of Divine Mercy will be celebrated in the Chapel. Mass will be offered on Thursday evenings at 6:30 and the Stations of the Cross will be celebrated each Friday evening at 6:30 in the chapel. For those who may not know about the Chaplet of Divine Mercy I would offer a brief explanation. The Chaplet is a devotion based on the visions of St. Faustina Kowalska, known as the Apostle of Mercy. She was a Polish sister of the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy, and was canonized a saint in 2000. It is a beautiful rosary-based devotion that includes music and traditional Catholic prayers. I hope that many of our parishioners will take advantage of the many devotions that are offered during these Lenten mornings and evenings.
