Dear Friends

Next Sunday is Palm Sunday and, as you know, the beginning of the most important week in the Liturgical

Year. It should be a special week for all of us. In order to prepare ourselves for Holy Week and for Easter, the Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available on Wed. March 28 and on Wed. April 4 from 7:00-8:00 in the evening.

St. John's has a history of very moving and beautiful liturgies during these sacred days and this year will be no different. The 10:00 Mass on Palm Sunday morning will be a special family Mass that will begin outside (weather permitting) on the lawn by the parking lot. The 6:00 evening Mass will be a special Teen Mass with our high school students proclaiming the Passion of our Lord.

On Holy Thursday, at 7:00 pm we will celebrate the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper with the Mandatum or the washing of the feet of 12 parishioners who will represent the 12 Apostles. Following the Mass, there will be the solemn procession of the Blessed Sacrament to the Chapel which will be open for prayer until 10:00 pm. On Good Friday, the Seven Last Words of Christ will be preached at 12 noon by the members of the East Bridgewater clergy association. I am happy to once again host this ecumenical service. That evening at 7:00, we will have the solemn Celebration of the Passion of our Lord. This is the only day of the year when Mass can't be celebrated. Within this beautiful liturgy, however, will be the distribution of Holy Communion and the Veneration of the Cross.

On Holy Saturday, we will have the Great Vigil of Easter at 7:00 pm. The Mass begins outside of the front doors of the church with the lighting of the Easter Fire and the blessing of the Pascal candle. During the Easter Vigil, three R.C.I. A. candidates will be received into the full communion of the Catholic Church. Please pray for these new members of the faith community: Christine Lombardi, Jennifer Mann, and John Hughes. On Easter Sunday, the Mass schedule will be 8:00, 9:30 and 11:30 with an Easter Egg hunt after the 9:30 Mass. May these days be blessed ones for all of us. *God Bless, Fr. Wally*
