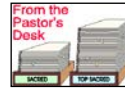

AdorationBoston ([www.AdorationBoston.org](http://www.AdorationBoston.org)) is proud to present the Vatican International Exhibition of The Eucharistic Miracles of the World on Sunday, June 2<sup>nd</sup> from 10:00 AM – 10:00 PM at St. Clement Eucharistic Shrine (1105 Boylston St, Boston) staffed by the Oblates of the Virgin Mary. This exhibit includes an extensive assortment of photographs and historical descriptions of some of the principle Eucharistic Miracles throughout the ages and across the globe. Each of the 140 miracles has been officially recognized by the Church.

Eucharistic miracles are God's extraordinary interventions, meant to confirm faith in the real presence of the body and blood of our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament. By means of this exhibit, you can "virtually visit" places of these great miracles like 8<sup>th</sup> Century Lanciano where the Host turned to Flesh and the Wine turned to Blood, and to Bolsena and Orvieto in 1263 and see the miracle that convinced Pope Urban IV to extend the Feast of Corpus Christi to the universal Church and prompted St. Thomas Aquinas to compose Tantum Ergo.
